



## **Operation Tiger Slapton Sands**

When we arrive at Slapton Sands our guide will explain exactly how the 943 men died just off the beach after their Tank Landina Ships were torpedoed by a High Speed German 'E' Boat on the 28th April 1944. In 1944 the beach was requisitioned for training in readiness for the D-Day Landings. Slapton Sands was chosen because of it's similarity to "Omaha" and "Utah" beaches.



At 0945 hours on April 27 1944 convoy T45 left Plymouth Harbour but as they neared Slapton Sands high speed German 'E' Boats torpedoed them resulting in the loss of 943 men of American Combined Services on board Landing Tank Ships 507 and 531 One of the Sherman tanks recovered from the sea bed now sits near the Start Bay Inn where we'll take a lunch break Don't miss this rare opportunity to hear the story and see the beach where it happened as we prepared for D-Day

## 2 hour cruise on WW11 ship 'Fairmile'

The coach will arrive in Dartmouth in good time for lunch and then at 2 00pm we'll set sail for a 2 hour cruise to Start Bay with a detailed commentary and views of Slapton and Blackpool beaches, where Operation Tiger took place after all the nearby villages were requisitioned for use as a training area for troops of the Combined Services in the planning for the Normandy Invasion In 1943, as part of the build-up to D-Day. later named Operation Overlord. the British Government set up a training around at Slapton Sands, to be used by Force "U", the American forces tasked with landing on Utah beach, Slapton Beach was selected for its similarity to Utah Beach, a largely pebble beach with a lake behind it.
