Monday 21st August for 5 days

Our Days Out will include Buxton, the beautiful 'Capital of The Peak District', then a guided coach tour around the Derbyshire Dales. Day three of our holiday will include a visit to Chatsworth House and its famed gardens. The following day we'll board a train for a four mile ride in to Matlock before heading to Crich for a tram ride in the open countryside so typical of The Peak District.

After riding on one of the heritage tramcars (pictured above)
what could be better than a visit to the Tea Rooms.

Crich is much more than just tram cars, a street of beautiful old buildings, rescued and carefully restored and rebuilt to give you the feeling of being back in an age when tramcars were a common sight in most cities, including horse drawn and steam trams. Take a stroll through this period village scene with shops and of course, a pub. Cheers!

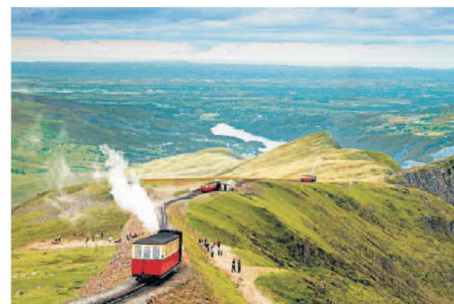
We've got some super day trips for you including:

Plas Newydd House and garden Set on the shores of the Menai Strait amidst breathtakingly beautiful scenery, this elegant house was redesigned by James Wyatt in the 18th century. Famous for its Rex Whistler collection includes the largest exhibition of his works.

The garden and arboretum, has shrubs and wild flowers, and massed hydrangeas giving lots of autumn colour

Snowdon Mountain Railway

From Llanberis station the track crosses the first of two viaducts across the river giving a wonderful view of the waterfall plunging into the gorge below. Soon we get our first glimpse of the peak of Snowdon above the ridge to our right. The train soon passes Bishops Field and the ruined Hebron Chapel before starting its summit ascent in earnest in spectacular scenery. Finally we are treated to one of the world's great panoramas as it reveals the Summit of Snowdon Mountain



The next day we'll take the 2 hour journey on the **Welsh Highland Railway** from Caernarfon to Porthmadog.

The trains are hauled by the world's most powerful narrow gauge steam locomotives climbing from sea level at Caernarfon to over 650ft on the foothills of Snowdon. They then zigzag dramatically down the steep hillside to Beddgelert, nestling in the heart of the National Park, then through the famous and magnificent Aberglaslyn Pass and on to Porthmadog.

Two of the most famous and the most scenic railway journeys in the World



Portmeirion Village and garden

Portmeirion is a popular tourist village in Gwynedd, North Wales. It was designed and built by Sir Clough Williams-Ellis between 1925 and 1975 in the style of an Italian village. Portmeirion has served as the location for numerous films and television shows. The famous Portmeirion Pottery was created by Susan Williams-Ellis, daughter of Sir Clough and at his request so that he could sell it in the gift shop



Our final day trip is The **Inigo Jones Slate Works Tour**

The Inigo Jones Slate Works was founded in 1861 to make school writing slates. When these were replaced by paper the company had to find new products and today they make lovely house name plates & gifts. The tour of the works is self guided and both educational and fun. After the introductory video presentation you can wander through the workshops at your own pace and view the machines and craftsmen in action, accompanied by your own personal taped commentary. This is a nice tour to be enjoyed at your own pace

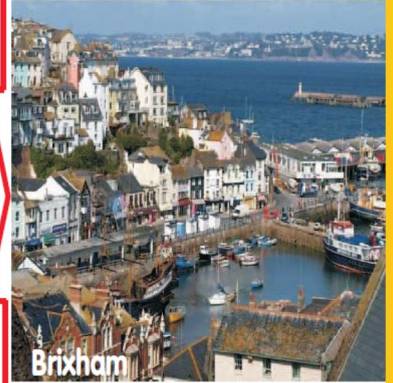
Ludlow Market Day Saturday 24th June £24.95
